## II. Researchers and MSCA



### Research Experience

- **Early Stage Researchers – ESR:** in their first 4 years of FTE research experience, no PhD at the **time of recruitment (ITN)**
- **Experienced Researchers – ER:** be in the possession of a doctoral degree or have at least 4 years of FTE research experience at the **deadline of submission (IF)**

### Mobility rule

- Must not have resided or carried out his/her main activity in the country of the host organisation for **more than 12 months in the 3 years prior to deadline of submission (IF) or prior to the time of recruitment (ITN)**
- IF exceptions
- No mobility rule in RISE

#### Academic Sector

## **Countries Not Eligible For EU Funding**



Countries not listed previously are not eligible for EU funding

*In practice, those countries are mainly:* Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, India, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Republic of Korea, Russia, United States.

In very exceptional cases, partners from those countries might be funded. But the following conditions have to be fulfilled:

- a) This partner has competences/expertise that no organisation in MS/AC has
- b) The relevant transfer of knowledge can only be done via a secondment in the direction TC → MS/AC
- c) Points a) and b) must be endorsed by the expert evaluators
- d) The experts' endorsement (point c) must be confirmed by the REA

# II. MSCA – ITN: Innovative Training Networks

- Train a new generation of **creative, entrepreneurial and innovative** early-stage researchers
- Raise **excellence and structure doctoral training** at European level

**Early Stage Researchers** recruited in the framework of an international and intersectorial network will:

- ✓ Work on a common research project with their specific individual research projects
- ✓ Improve scientific skills and benefit from a complementary training on transferable skills
- ✓ Benefit from networking activities (summer courses, conferences ...)
- ✓ Duration: 48 months, recruitment of ESR: 3-36 months





# II. European Fellowships IF - EF

### STANDARD EUROPEAN FELLOWSHIP

- ER of any nationality
- Mobility from any country to the MS / AC where the host institution is located
- Mobility rule.
- Duration of the project: 12 - 24 months

Any researcher: ST – CAR - SE

Specific mobility rule applies to CAR, RI and SE

### CAREER RESTART PANEL (CAR)

- Researchers who want to resume research in Europe after a break in research
- Multidisciplinary Panel
- ER of any nationality, host institution located in MS / AC.
- Break in research: not active in research for at least 12 months prior to the deadline of submission
- Duration of the project: 12-24 months

### REINTEGRATION PANEL (RI)


- Support to researchers who want to return and reintegrate in a longer term research position in Europe
- Multidisciplinary Panel
- Mobility from a Third Country to a MS / AC
- ER: nationals or long-term residents of a MS / AC
- Duration of the project: 12-24 months

### SOCIETY AND ENTERPRISE PANEL (SE):

- Research and innovation projects in non-academic sector
- Facilitating career moves between the academic and non-academic sector
- Only competition with other projects in non-academic sector (10 M€ for 2016)

## II. Global Fellowships IF - GF

### Global Fellowships



- Duration: 12-24 months, outgoing phase in a TC + 12 months returning phase in Europe.
- ER eligible: **nationals and long-term residents in MS / AC**
- Mobility from any country to the TC of the outgoing phase
- Mobility rule to be fulfilled in the TC of the outgoing phase**
- Minimum participation: 1 beneficiary in MS / AC (host institution) + 1 Partner Organisation in TC
- Letter of Commitment** from Partner Organisation in TC compulsory






## IF-EF 2014: A-list per country







## RDF: Research Development Framework (ej VITAE)





15 PhD positions (3-years) are offered within the Marie Skłodowska-Curie ITN-MSCA Project REP-BIOTECH. The project is coordinated by the University of Murcia (Spain). The individual research projects are detailed below.

These 3-year positions will begin in March-April 2016, but expressions of interest should be sent to repbiotech@um.es before November 30th 2015.

## Description

Researchers must be in the first four years of their research careers and have not yet been awarded a doctoral degree at the time of recruitment. Admission to the programme is open to applicants who hold either 2nd Level Master Degree (120 ECTS + 180 ECTS in a bachelor degree) or a Single Cycle Degree (minimum 300 ECTS), or a comparable university degree (Second Cycle qualification), as required by the REP-BIOTECH partner universities for admission to doctoral studies.

The individual research projects are detailed below. The expressions of interest should be sent to repbiotech@um.es. The project title to which the application is addressed (maximum 3 projects) must be quoted in the title of the message.

Project 1. Associations between vitamin D and male reproductive parameters.

Project 2. Sex determination in cattle and pigs.

Project 3. Relationship between Nitric oxide (NO) in follicular fluid and sperm fertilization ability.
