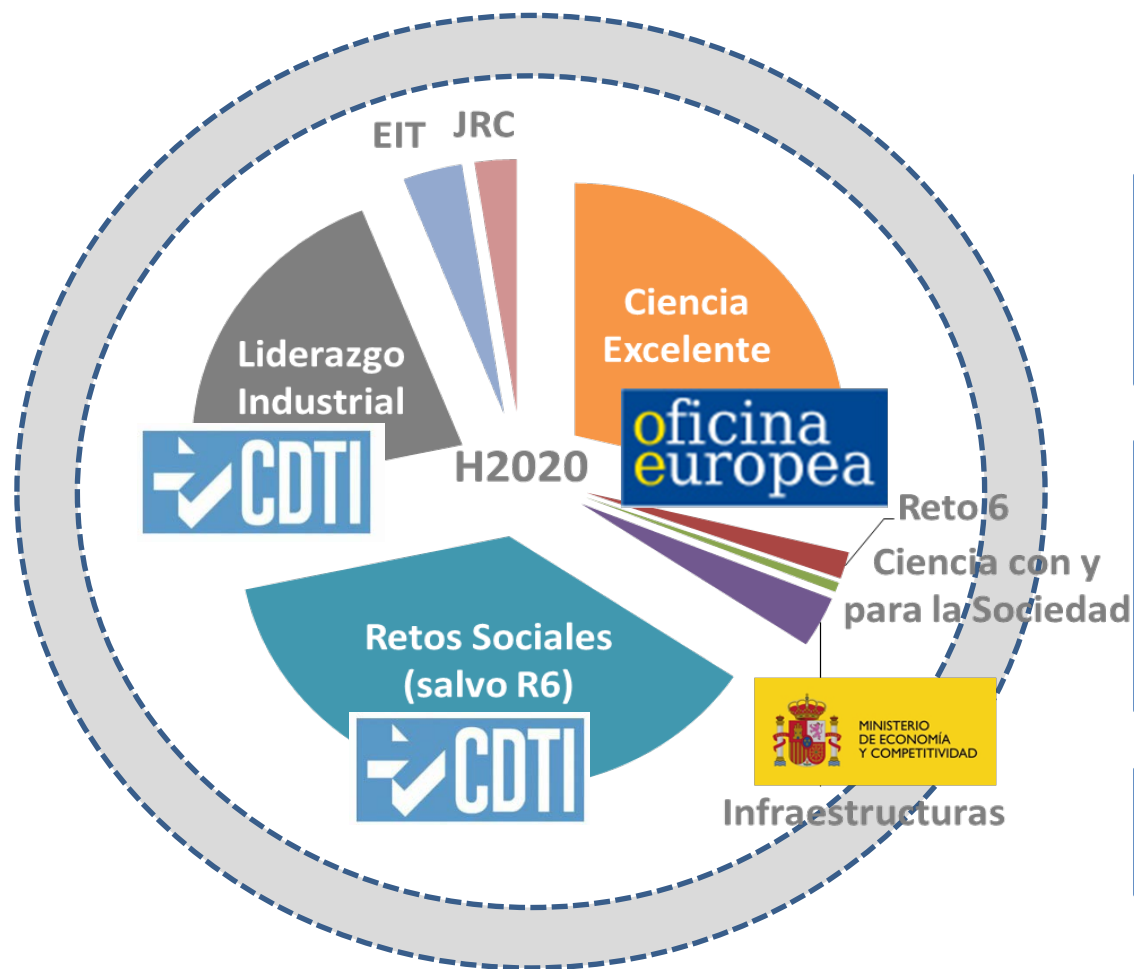

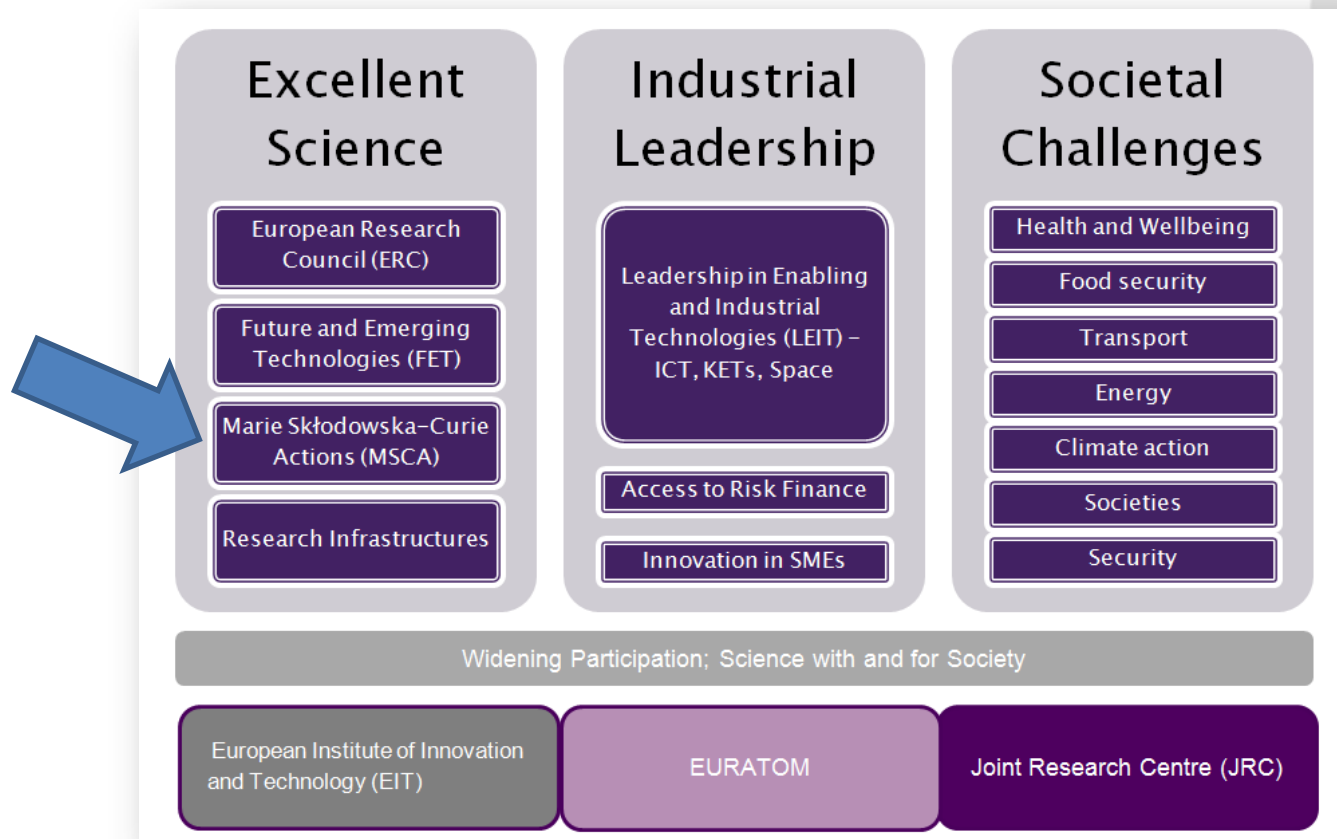

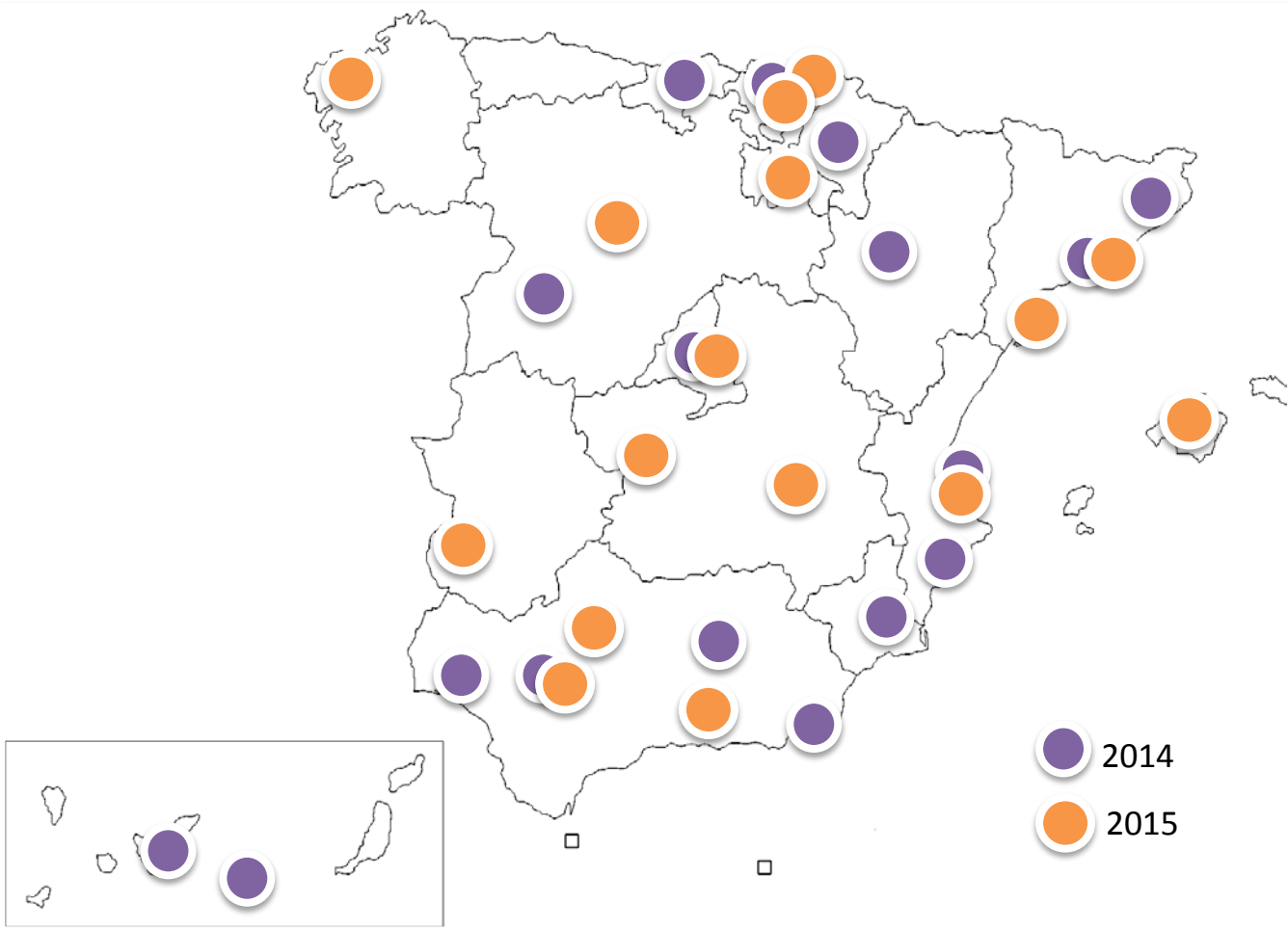

Research Experience

- **Early Stage Researchers – ESR:** in their first 4 years of FTE research experience, no PhD at the **time of recruitment (ITN)**
- **Experienced Researchers – ER:** be in the possession of a doctoral degree or have at least 4 years of FTE research experience at the **deadline of submission (IF)**

Mobility rule

- Must not have resided or carried out his/her main activity in the country of the host organisation for **more than 12 months in the 3 years prior to deadline of submission (IF) or prior to the time of recruitment (ITN)**
- IF exceptions
- No mobility rule in RISE

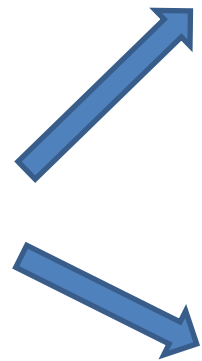

Countries Not Eligible For EU Funding



Countries not listed previously are **not eligible for EU funding**

In practice, those countries are mainly: Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, India, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Republic of Korea, Russia, United States.

In **very exceptional cases**, partners from those countries might be funded. But the following conditions have to be fulfilled:

- This partner has competences/expertise that **no** organisation in MS/AC has
- The relevant transfer of knowledge can only be done via a secondment in the direction TC → MS/AC
- Points a) and b) must be endorsed by the expert evaluators
- The experts' endorsement (point c) must be confirmed by the REA

- ❑ Train a new generation of **creative, entrepreneurial and innovative** early-stage researchers
- ❑ Raise **excellence and structure doctoral training** at European level

Early Stage Researchers recruited in the framework of an international and intersectorial network will:

- ✓ Work on a common research project with their specific individual research projects
- ✓ Improve scientific skills and benefit from a complementary training on transferable skills

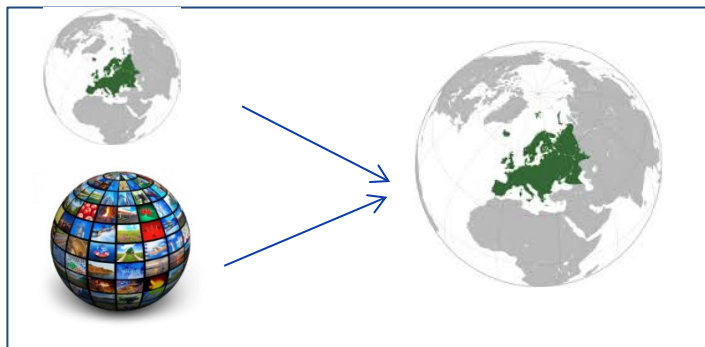

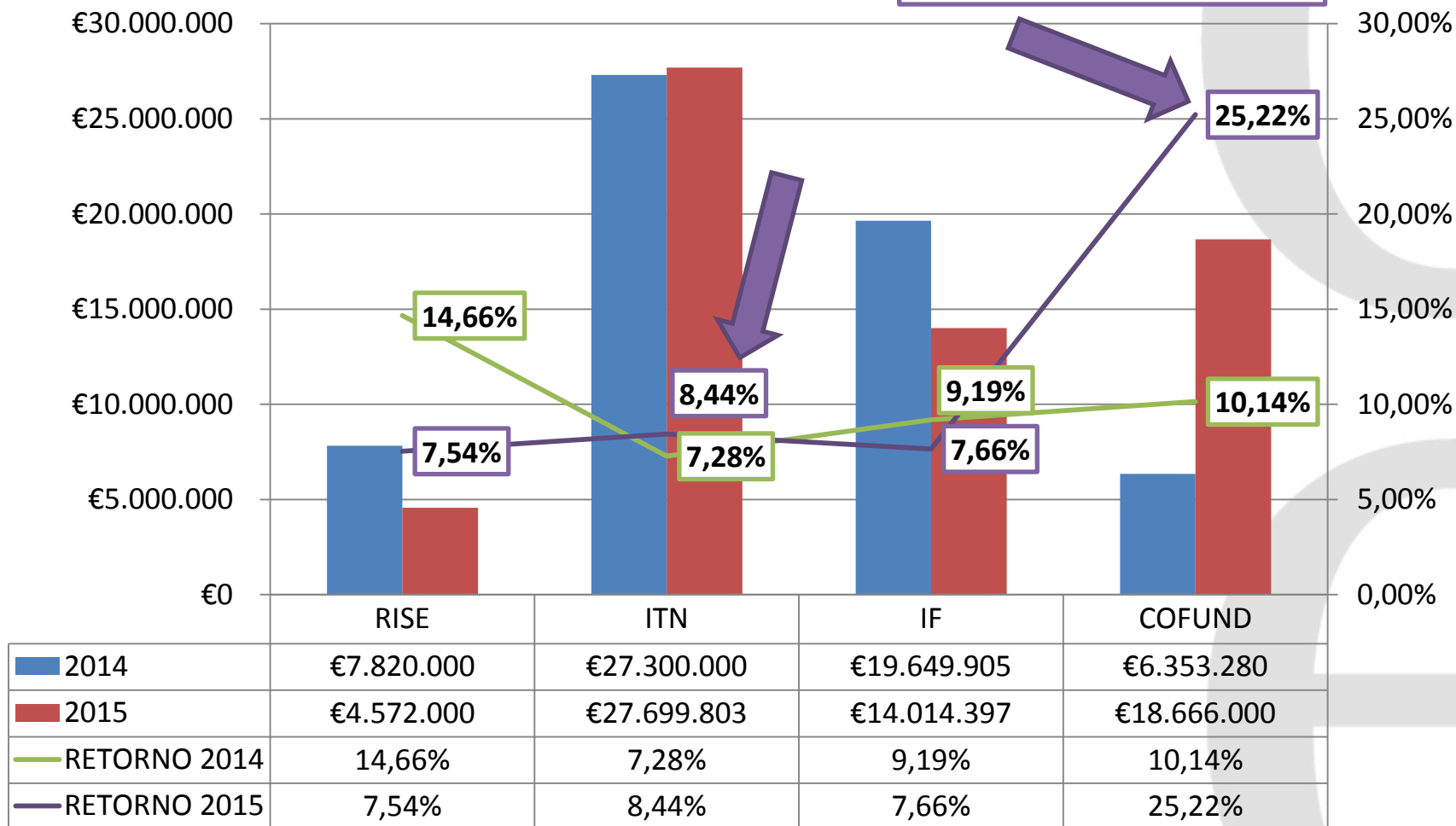

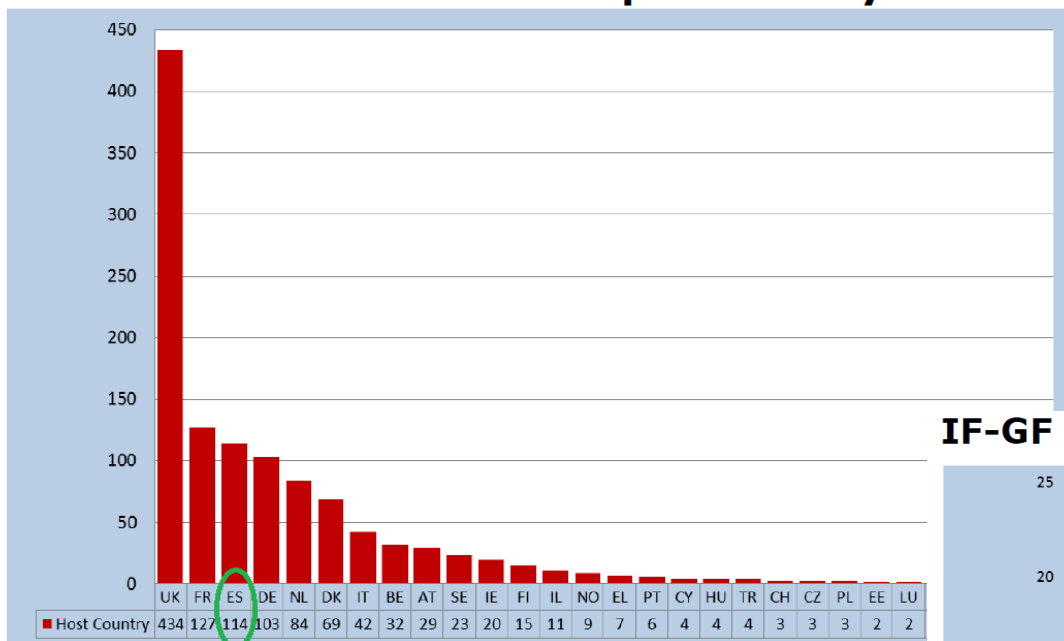

IF-EF 2014: A-list per country

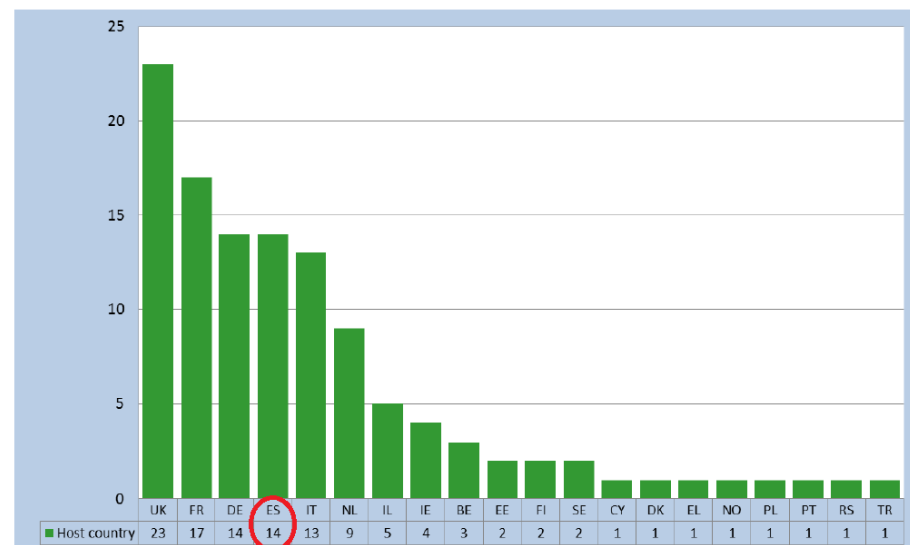

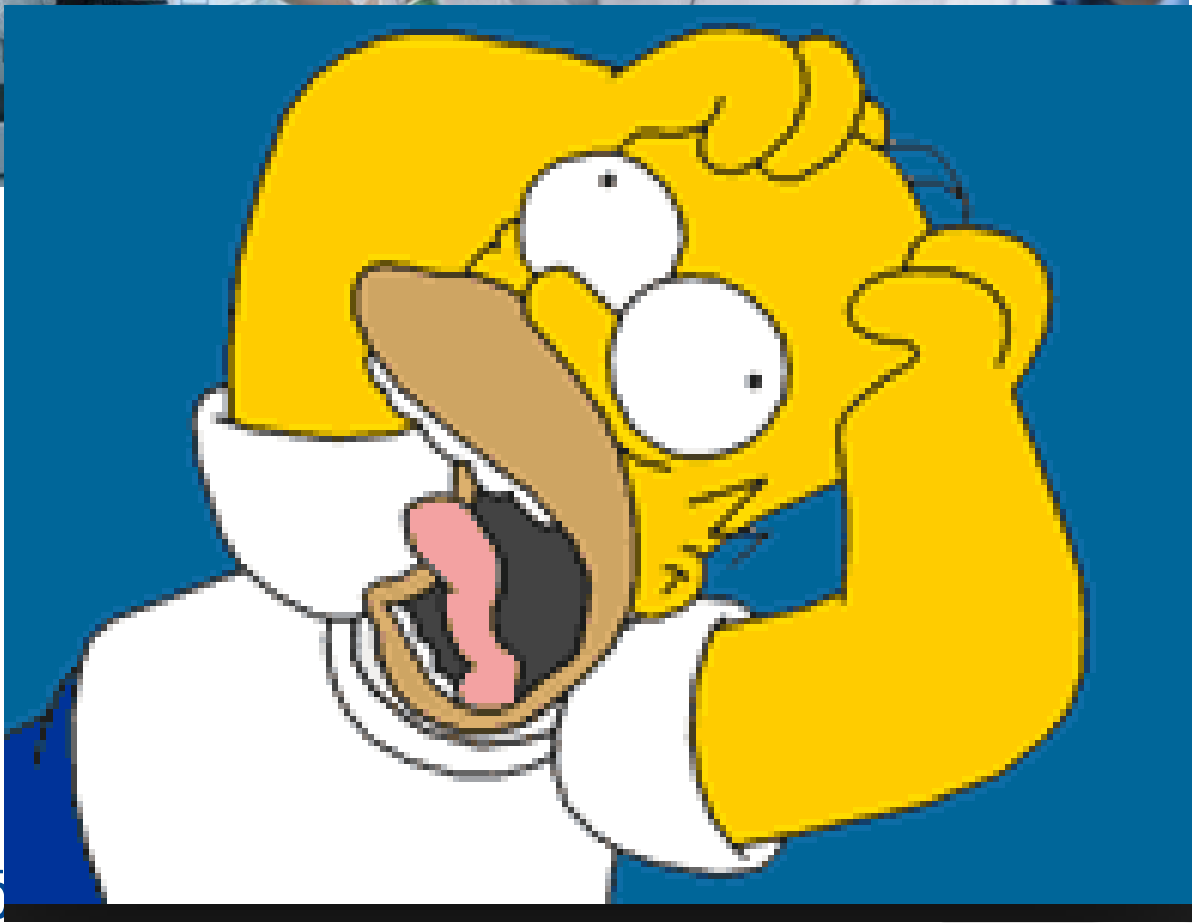

RDF: Research Development Framework (ej VITAE)



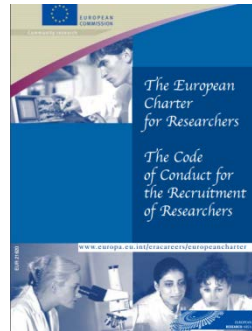

Researchers must be in the first four years of their research careers and have not yet been awarded a doctoral degree at the time of recruitment. Admission to the programme is open to applicants who hold either 2nd Level Master Degree (120 ECTS + 180 ECTS in a bachelor degree) or a Single Cycle Degree (minimum 300 ECTS), or a comparable university degree (Second Cycle qualification), as required by the REP-BIOTECH partner universities for admission to doctoral studies.

Madrid-MIT M+VISION CONSORTIUM The international call M+VISION COFUND 2015 offering fellowships for researchers in biomedical imaging in Madrid and Boston has been published on 14th May.

The Regional Ministry for Education of Comunidad de Madrid offers 10 fellowships for specialists on advanced research in biomedical imaging. This call is part of M+VISION, a program in collaboration of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and co-funded by the Seventh Framework Programme of the European Union.

Initially, the fellowship lasts for 12 months that can be prolonged with a 24-month contract, provided that there is a host organisation (university, research centre, hospital or firm) based in Madrid that hires the researchers during the second and third year. Host organizations will have a co-financing of up to 57% for hiring the researchers.

The economic support consists of:

- Fellowship (first year): 43,000 € / year
- Employment contract (second and third year): € 65,000 / year (Employer cost, including social security charges)
- Research costs: 2,300 € / year
- Travel costs: 3,300 € / year
